Nitrogen is commercially recovered from the air as ammonia, which is produced by combining nitrogen in the atmosphere with hydrogen from natural gas. Ammonia is converted to other nitrogen compounds, the most important of which are urea (NH₂CONH₂), nitric acid (HNO₃), ammonium nitrate (NH₄NO₃), and ammonium sulfate [(NH₄)₂SO₄].
